## Important Information for International Students

#### **△** A STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE

- 1 International students are required to complete <u>eForm16</u> via ICA-SOLAR.
- 2 Upload supporting documents and make payment for the processing fees.
- 3 After obtaining the In-Principle Approval (IPA) letter, make payment for the student pass issuance fees.
- 4 Complete the online matriculation with SMU and other necessary steps listed on the <u>matriculation website</u>.
- 6 Before arranging for travel to Singapore, please also check the <u>Singapore ICA website</u> on the latest entry criteria, travel checklists, and list of accepted COVID-19 vaccinations applicable for entry to Singapore. If you need to reach out to the Singapore Safe Travel office (STO), please visit <a href="https://safetravel.ica.gov.sg/contact-us">https://safetravel.ica.gov.sg/contact-us</a> for details.

- **6** Get ready to travel to Singapore. Do check the prevailing <u>border</u> controls.
- 7 Serve the Stay-Home-Notice (SHN), if required, upon arrival in Singapore.
- 8 Attend medical examination after SHN.
- 9 Upload the medical results and documents for student pass issuance and wait for the Singapore Immigration and Checkpoints Authority's (ICA) approval.
- Make e-appointment with ICA in Singapore to collect student pass.
- Refer to the <u>matriculation website</u> for steps to complete your online ID verification.

# Postgraduate Research Programmes' (PGR) Onboarding & Orientation and Academic Briefings

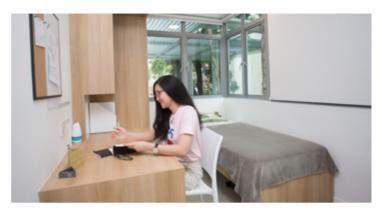

#### Voices@SMU

SMU endeavours to provide a safe study and work environment for all members of our community. We believe that everyone has the principal right to feel secure, protected and respected within SMU.

<u>Voices@SMU</u>, a unit that resides within Student Services Hub (SSH), assists and supports students the affected by harassment or violence – including cases of sexual harassment or sexual assault.

As the designated first-response unit for harassment or violence cases, Voices@SMU gives students (reporting or accused parties) a safe and central place to be heard. # What is the mode of instruction for the new Academic Term starting August 2022?

Classes will be conducted on campus for all programmes, except for classes which are designed to be conducted in a blended learning approach. Instructors are given the discretion to provide consultation sessions and remote learning opportunities for students who are absent due to sickness, family emergencies or other unforeseen circumstances.

#### **Would I have to be quarantined upon entry into Singapore?**

All international students will be subject to the prevailing border measures upon entry into Singapore. This could include quarantine or Stay-Home- Notices (SHN). More instructions will be shared with you before your arrival. View <a href="here">here</a> for updated details. Before arranging for travel to Singapore, please also check the <a href="Singapore ICA website">Singapore ICA website</a> on the latest entry criteria, travel checklists, and list of accepted COVID-19 vaccinations applicable for entry to Singapore.

#### If I am an international student, when can I come to Singapore?

Singapore has implemented a COVID-19 Vaccinated Travel Framework to facilitate the resumption of travel. All incoming International Students (not Singapore citizens/permanent residents) who are currently overseas should refer to the <u>Safe Travel Office (STO) website</u> for information on Traveller entry checklists under Vaccinated Travel Framework and Accepted COVID-19 Vaccinations for Entry to Singapore. Students may need to obtain additional documentation. If you need to reach out to the Singapore Safe Travel Office (STO), please visit <u>ICA</u> for details.

#### **Does my student insurance cover COVID-19 infections?**

All matriculated students are covered under the <u>student insurance</u> <u>scheme</u> which covers the hospitalisation fees in Singapore if you contract COVID-19. For the latest information on claims and coverage, please refer to SMU Student Services Hub.

#### Who should I contact in SMU if I am feeling unwell?

There is a clinic located within SMU's campus at which you can seek assistance. You can also visit SMU's <u>panel clinics</u> located across Singapore. For medical emergencies, the Emergency Medical Service (EMS) in Singapore is operated by the Singapore Civil Defence Force (SCDF) and it can be reached by dialling 995.
