FINANCIAL AIDS – CONFERENCE FUND

- PhD students may apply for conference funding up to a maximum of **\$\$3,500**.
- This can be used to cover trip expenses such as airfare, accommodation, conference registration/membership fees, meal expenses, etc.

Eligibility

- ✓ in his/her **2nd or subsequent year**
- ✓ the **author or co-author** of the paper, presenting at a refereed conference
- ✓ in good academic standing

FINANCIAL AIDS – RESEARCH GRANT

PhD students may apply for **internal** (max. S\$800/ year) & **external** research grant

- Singapore children's society (\$2,000)
- Summer school research grant (USD1,000)
 by Asian Association of Social Psychology (USD 1,000)
- Mini research grant program (USD 1,000)
 by the International Society for Self and Identity

FINANCIAL AIDS – SCHOLARSHIP

Presidential (PDF) and **Interdisciplinary (IDF)** Doctoral Fellowship Awards

If you are awarded the fellowship award during your scholarship period, you will receive a higher monthly stipend. In addition, a S\$3,500 research trip will be provided.
